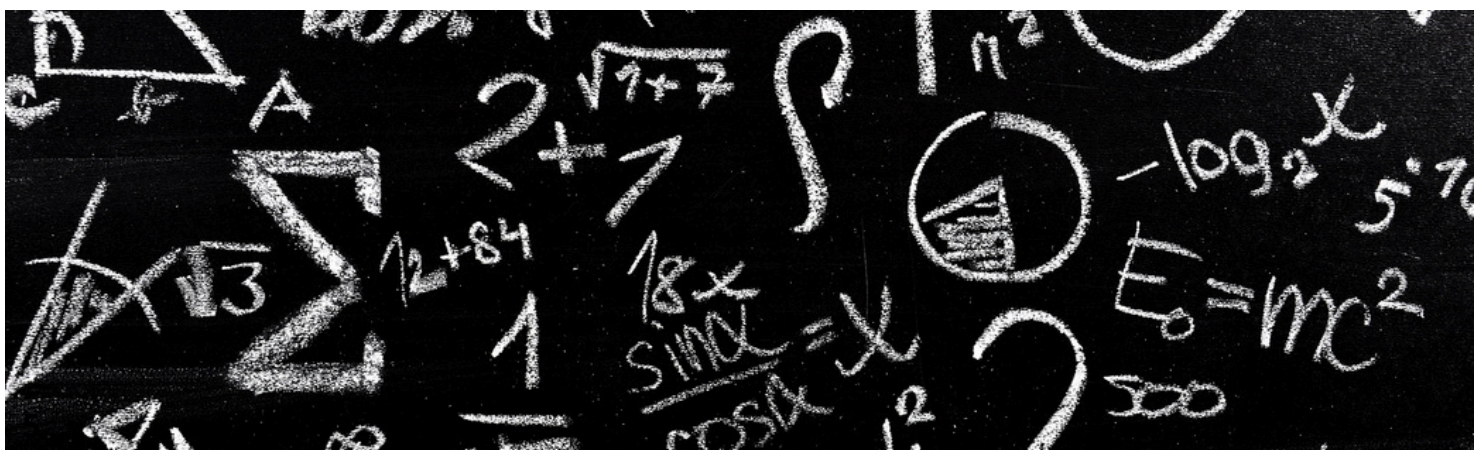
British Universities Visit
